SUNTORY THE CHITA SINGLE GRAIN

Chita is the serenity of Japanese whisky, from the inventive grain whisky distillery in the Chita Peninsula dedicated to the pursuit of making diverse grain whiskies. The Chita is a very pale straw colour, as you would expect from a pure grain whisky. The nose is very light and sweet, with baked cereal and pear-like notes, and a tinge of liquorice edging into a slightly charred note.

HINOTORY 5YO JAPANESE BLENDED

Coming back from its ashes is exactly what the Hekinan distillery, located in Aichi and founded in 1949, is doing by releasing a limited 5 years old batch made from malt and grain in a pot still.

Ageing takes place in used whisky barrels for 5 years to allow gentle and smooth aromas to develop.

NIKKA COFFEY MALT

While the Nikka Coffey Malt is produced from 100% malt in a single distillery, it is not technically a single malt whisky due to its distillation method in Coffey stills, which are normally used for grain whisky production. This rare 100% malt bottling offers a surprisingly rich texture with deep oaky notes.
